2024 IDAHO STATE 500-600-OK CLUBS TOURNAMENT RULES

- Changes started with the 2010 tournament: **Participants in any event bowl 4 games handicap doubles. All Clubs will consist of 4 handicap games (two (2) games on two (2) different pairs of lanes)**
- Changes started with the 2004 tournament; **Bowlers must show their USBC card, National 500 Club or National 600 Club and THEY MUST ALSO SHOW either the State 500, 600 or OK Club card {whichever applies}.**

Each participant shall purchase and show their lifetime State 500 or 600 or OK Club card (\$3.00 one-time fee).

1. Your name, complete address, telephone number and email address must be listed on **each** entry. The information provided is used for confirmation, schedule changes, mailing prize lists and/or checks.
2. Entrants shall use their **highest USBC certified league average from the previous winter season of 21 or more games**. An entrant without a previous winter may use her highest USBC certified league average of 21 or more games as of entry closing date. Average is to be verified by the association or league secretary. Space is provided on the front of the entry. All others bowl scratch (220).
3. Failure to use correct average shall disqualify the scores if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification of more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series.
4. All clubs will have **ONLY** one division until at least 30 entries in that club are received. After the minimum entries are received in any of the clubs, they will be split as evenly as possible into two divisions. Entries received at the tournament site will be placed in the correct division with no readjustment of divisions.
5. 500 600 OK Club bowlers will have an **INDIVIDUAL SCRATCH EVENT**.
6. Pacers will not be allowed.
7. Handicap is based on 100% of a 220 average.
8. **Entrants shall check in ½ hour prior to squad time.** Arrange for any schedule changes or eligible substitutes within your own association.
9. All bowlers will be expected to conduct themselves in an exemplary manner.
10. In case of a tie, place money will be added together and divided equally.
11. Tournament secretary will draft a schedule and prize list.
12. Entries will be scheduled as received except those living within 50 miles of the host association.
13. **Multiple participation is allowed**. Cash only once with the same partner in each division. Enter as many times as you wish, as long as: lanes are available up to the start of the last scheduled squad.
14. Optional Singles Handicap: In no case is an individual permitted to place more than once in a prize list for position standings.
15. All entries must be postmarked by May 12, 2024. In order to be accepted.
16. All other USBC rules governing the tournament shall apply.
17. Rule 319a-2, 319-d, 319-e do not apply.
18. Entrants whose names appear heron or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Idaho State 500-600-OK Clubs, its officers and agents shall be liable to the extent of returning entry fees if and when those entrants shall be prevented from bowling the event in the tournament through delay, unexpected, necessary emergency or strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Idaho State 500-600-OK Club's tournament officers.
19. 500-600-OK Clubs' annual meeting is the Saturday evening of the tournament.
