Rules on Back

USBC Open High 5 Rules and Format

1. Round robin baker format, with position rounds if needed

(The number of position rounds will depend on the number of teams)

- 2. Depending on the number of entries, the tournament director may split the teams into two divisions as evenly as possible. Any such split will be based on the team's average.
- **3.** Use last season's high average 21 games or more. (Must have an average from last season in the center they are representing) and bowling currently in that Center.
- 4. All Bowling is Scratch
- **5.** Prize fund returned 100 Percent. With the prize ratio of 1 in 4. Based on 12 teams, (1st \$580 2nd \$300 3rd \$200) Pay out to follow event Saturday night
- 6. Open to current USBC members only
- Each association or center is encouraged to send at least 1 team made up of 5 bowlers. All 5 bowlers must bowl league in same center. Must be Idaho or Washington USBC member
- 8. Any subs not from the team's center, must have the same or lower average than the bowler being replaced, if approved by Tournament director.
- 9. Scoring Scratch pin fall plus 30 pins for a win and 15 for a tie
- **10.**If a tie exists after the final game in a paying position a one game baker roll off will be used to break the tie.
- 11. Dress Code: Same as Open State
- **12.** Any conflicts will be resolved by tournament management.
- 13. No entries accepted if postmarked after March 24, 2024
- 14. Tournament Directors Wally Studer and Justin Studer

Optional: \$25 brackets Games 2,3,4 & 6,7,8 & 10,11,12 Full Bracket will pay 1st \$125 and 2nd \$65
